Pro classes 20”:	A and AA Pro and Pro Ladies
Other Classes:	30 Plus Masters Open Wheel Old School Racing. (Pre A Head & Pre V Brakes)

Format

AA, A & Pro Ladies: Three Motos and a final **Each Day**

All Other classes: **Saturday** : – Three (3) Motos **Sunday** – Two (2) Motos and Finals.

These classes will be conducted over two days, with points through motos, dead man semis and dead man finals.

Classes with 8 or less, ALL RIDERS progress to a sixth moto. Invitation Finals will be run for all classes except pro classes.

Registration, Transponder Fitting & Practice

All riders must register and produce their current BMXA licence

Registration & Transponder fitting : Friday 4th November: 5:00pm to 7.30pm

Saturday 5th November: 3:00pm to 5:00pm.

Motos will be drawn after close of Registration.

Practice: Friday evening 5:00 pm to 7:30 pm. (Open gate practice, \$2 per rider)

Saturday Graded Practice from 4:15. Schedule available at Registration or on the Knox Web Site

Sunday All age classes & old school racing 8:00 to 9:15. A/AA, 30+, Pro Ladies 9:15 to 9:30

Note: Full Regulation race gear must be worn and race plate with race numbers displayed during practice.

Conditions of Entry

- All riders must hold a current Sprocket or Open BMXA licence. Club licences or 3 ride permits are not acceptable.
- If insufficient entries are received to form a Class at closing date, riders will be allocated to the most appropriate Class.
- Determination of age for all classes is year of competition minus year of birth for all classes.
- No refunds, unless:
 - It is found after the close of entries that a rider's nominated Class is not available and a suitable alternative class is not available; or
 - A rider is injured or becomes ill prior to the event and produces a medical certificate, in which case an administration fee will be deducted.
- It is the riders' responsibility:
 - To check if an entry has been received. Entry lists will be progressively updated on the Knox BMX web site www.knoxbmx.com.au or BMXV web site www.bmxv.com.au
 - To ensure they register, check moto sheets, attend staging on time and ride in their correct moto.
- Riders who fail to register will not be included in moto draw
- Where there are 8 or less competitors in a Class all riders have a sixth moto
- Pro classes: One entry fee is for two days of racing with prize money paid on each day. Any pro rider wishing to only enter one day call Graeme Anderson on 0419 569 682
- Transponders will be used for all riders except sprockets. Riders riding two classes using 2 bikes (e.g. Cruiser & 20" or 20" & Old School) MUST have 2 transponders.
